

Alvirne Community Garden Rules

This form is for you. Please keep it in a handy place.

Plots are \$25 each. Due paid by **April 17** to help cover garden expenses.

Please keep the shed organized. You are welcome to keep tools and equipment in the shed but it **must have your name on each item.**

Items stored in the shed over the winter without names, will be labeled as community garden and be available for use by anyone.

Weed barrier such as landscape fabric, black plastic, paper **MUST BE PULLED UP AND REMOVED FROM THE PROPERTY by OCTOBER 1.**

Plants may remain in the garden to grow longer, but ALL weed barrier and structures MUST be down and removed by **OCTOBER 1.**

Hoses are the property of the Community Garden. Please leave them in the rows and treat them with respect so that they will last.

I will bring and use my own hose nozzle and I will leave hoses in the main rows and walkways.

I will have something planted in the garden or keep my plot mulched against weed growth by **June 15** and keep my plot planted/tended all summer long.

Since the garden is on school property, I will not use alcohol or tobacco in the garden.

If I cannot take care of my plot for *any reason*, I will notify the CTE office at Alvirne or the garden coordinator, Suzanne at 603-595-4828 or email suzroark@comcast.net

I will keep weeds at a minimum in my plot and help keep weeds down in all walkways.

During the school year, I will garden before 7 a.m. or between 2:30 p.m. and sunset or on weekends and will park in the designated parking spaces.

I understand that I will carry-in/carry-out any trash and I will keep trash and litter out of the plot, as well as from adjacent pathways.

I will clean up my garden plot in the fall, garden structures must removed by **October 1**. Items can become frozen into the ground after this date.

I will NOT put trash or any weed barrier in the compost pile.

I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another plot user.

I will not bring pets to the garden and will not enter any farm buildings or pens.

Plots not cleaned up by October 1st may jeopardize membership in the community garden the following year.
